Winery Gober&Freinbichler, Neckenmark. We met Dominik Gober in front of his winery and he drove us to two of his vineyards in Horitschon and Neckenmark. Two different Terroirs which are essential for their philosophy and wine style. The two friends started the winery in 2015, the production and the tasting are in an old garage, where we tasted next to big old barrels. He offered all his wines plus barrel-samples and snacks. The whole winery is made with an eye for details and looks very welcoming for visitors.

Winery Uwe Schiefer, Welgersdorf. We had an appointment for a wine-tasting with the cellar master, because the owner was not available on this day. He already had a big tasting this morning and just finished cleaning up when we arrived at the winery. We got a very wide range of his wines also in different vintages. The tasting room was in the first floor with a big window into the wine cellar, very impressive. The knowledge and know-how of the cellar master was outstanding. We had a very good time.

Winery Hazic, Croatia. The winery is in the very north of Croatia next to the Hungarian and the Slovenian border. It is situated on a small hill directly in between the vineyards. The winery is with 2,5 ha by far the smallest of our tour. Next to the wine production the two sisters are producing apple juice and selling local products in their little wine house. They are working with a lot of passion and energy and reflect this very good to the visitors. We also had the feeling that the "Hazic Wine House" is a meeting point for locals.

First of all, I really do like to have an appointment when I'm visiting a winery. I think it's polite to the winemaker and also, I don't have any bad surprise. I really appreciate a short tour to the vineyard, when the winemaker explains the terroir and how he works in the vineyard. I want to get a feeling for region and the producer. It's easier for me to follow the explanations during the tasting when I have some background knowledge. For the tasting I like it when everything is prepared, and if they offer some bread for the tasting. Also, a little tour through the production and the wine cellar always made my whole experience better. If they offer some barrel-samples directly in the cellar, extra plus points. In the end it should be possible to buy some wine, or get them shipped home. Very important that they except card payment. At last, a 100% must have is: A friendly and respectful representative of the winery, doesn't matter if it's the owner, winemaker, cellar master or salesperson. I want to feel welcome there.
